## WARNING AGAINST FRAUDULENT BUSINESS SOLICITATIONS

**WATCH OUT!** Several independent companies do not hesitate to use the ADF Meeting branding to try to sell you so-called services, with the sole purpose of obtaining your data and your money fraudulently.

For example, Expoguide and International Fairguide offer to update your company data for free but simply sending back their "ADF Meeting" document actually equates to signing a contract and committing to pay for the service.

Other companies are apparently offering for sale a database listing the names and contact details of persons who allegedly attend our Meeting. The ADF knows nothing of this database or how it was compiled. The ADF, in strict accordance with its obligations, divulges absolutely none of the information in its contact database, and takes legal action against the perpetrators of fraudulent service offers as soon as they are brought to its notice.

In short, to save yourself from having to pay an unwanted service, please make sure that the person contacting you is a genuine ADF representative or a registered ADF partner or contractor.

Stay vigilant and do not hesitate to contact us should you have any doubts.

And if you need to update your contact details for the ADF publications, remember that the only thing you need to do is to log in to your ADF Exhibitor Account at [exposants.adf.asso.fr](http://exposants.adf.asso.fr) and update them there. There are no other formalities.
